
## Outpatient later abortion services (22+ weeks) and restrictions, March 2015

(Services available in the absence of maternal or fetal indicators)

- No outpatient services after 22 weeks LMP (since last menstrual period) Up to 22 weeks/6 days Up to 23 weeks/6 days Up to 24 weeks/6 days Up to 26 weeks
- X Ban on ALL later abortions except to save life of woman. The number following the "X in each case indicates the number of weeks <u>after fertilization</u> at which the ban applies. (20 weeks after fertilization is 22 weeks LMP.)
- \*There is an injunction on Georgia's 20-week ban.

A comparison with the 2010 and 2013 maps below shows the changes in services between 2010 and 2015. Map is current as of March 11, 2015.




## Outpatient later abortion services (22+ weeks) and restrictions, September 2013
